

AGREEMENT

WHEREAS there are 2 groups both purporting to be the Council of Management of the United Muslim Association of Hong Kong (“UMAH”), and whereas both are desirous of putting an end to their division as a result of mediation process facilitated by the prominent members of the Muslim community in the best interest of UMAH and the wider Muslim community in Hong Kong. The representatives of both sides attended a mediation meeting on 20 November, 2010 at the Conference Room of the Islamic Union of Hong Kong and agreed that Mr. Jamil Raghbi and Mr. Yusuf Yu shall act as the contact persons from each side for further follow up in order to reach a pragmatic solution acceptable to both groups. As a result of communication between both sides, the following terms have been mutually agreed.

1. The 2 Management Councils shall nominate 4 of their members each to form a combined Interim Management Council of UMAH.
2. The acting chairman (Rita Din), Hon Secretary (Nadeem Tahir), and Hon Treasurer (Ayub Din) shall be confirmed by the members of the interim council of management at its first meeting.
3. The Interim Council of Management (8 members, 4 from each group) shall be responsible to administer all the UMAH affairs including but not limited to the operation of UMAH International Primary School, Haji Omar Ramju Sadick Care and Attention Home and the Sheng Shui Mosque Project.
4. The Interim Council of Management (8 members, 4 from each group) shall approve a joint list of members. Both groups may register new members. The cut off date for the registration of new members shall be 12th of April, 2011. Registration of the new membership shall be done by duly completing the application form and paying the annual membership fee \$120 per member. Both groups are required to keep a clear record of the membership forms and official receipts for the membership fee.
5. Once the list of members has been approved by the Interim Council of Management (8 members, 4 from each group), the Interim Council of Management shall set a date, time and place for an Extraordinary General Meeting to be held before 15th May 2011. The Meeting Agenda and List of Members shall be posted or delivered to each member (or interested parties for information purpose). As per the requirement stipulated in the Memorandum and Articles of the United Muslim Association of Hong Kong, the signatures of at least 25% of the old members (those who were members before January, 2010) shall be obtained. The Agenda of the EGM shall be mutually discussed and approved by the Interim Council of Management.
6. There shall be no return from this position by either side.
